Club Changing And Showering Policy **February 2006**

Ickenham Cricket Club has adopted the following changing and showering policies. These may be modified after individual discussion with parents (for example to involve disabled players who require additional support or assistance).

Colts Matches

- The club does not provide showering facilities at colts' matches. All young players will be encouraged to shower or bath at home.
- Adults working with colts' teams must not change or shower at the same time, using the same facility, as young players aged under 16.
- Young players aged 10 and under must be supervised at all times in changing rooms by two members of the Cricket and Club Staff[1] of the same gender as the young players.
- Mixed gender teams must have access to separate male and female changing rooms. Normally girls having exclusive use of the 3rd XI changing room will achieve this for home matches.

Senior Matches

Consent must be given (on a Parent's consent form available from the Club Welfare Officer) for all young players (16 or over) to play for a senior side. This provides the option of sharing changing facilities with the senior side or from opting out. Opting out recognises that some young people are uncomfortable changing or showering in public
